## DOMESTIC PLAYER CLEARANCE PROCEDURE

At times a player may find themselves moving to a team which is different to the one they played for in the previous season. Players may move Domestic Clubs or non-Club teams when entering a new season by acquiring a player clearance which allows them to transfer from one to the other.

If the player did not play in the previous season, a player clearance in not necessary, however if the player is unfinancial or owes property to the previous team or Club, and that team or Club action it, this may be looked at further in the new season.

\*\*\* Example of not needing a player clearance to transfer: The player did not play in a team for Winter 2023 and will be playing in a new team for Summer 2023-24.

## PROCEDURE

- Players must fill in the player clearance form found on the RBRA website
- The player moving to a different team or Club from the previous season, must fill in section 1
- The Club or non-Club team organiser must fill in section 2
- The player must then **submit the form via email** with both section 1 and 2 completed to finalise the transfer

- A reply email will be sent to the player, and teams or Club to notify them that the transfer has been approved
