AGM 2022

The Board has scheduled the AGM for September 2022.

This has been necessary because the Board will propose an updated Constitution for the members at the AGM. In addition there are a number of actions the Board will take in response to the Marvin Report.

The Board had previously identified the requirement to update the constitution in the interest in maintaining good governance and ensure currency, however, this need has been further highlighted by the recommendations of the Marvin Report and recent events.

Our legal advice confirms that according to the current constitution only Ordinary Members can vote, and requires that to become an Ordinary Member, and obtain voting rights, the applicant must:

1. apply to the Association in writing;
2. be proposed by an existing member;
3. both the proposing member and the applicant must sign the application form; and
4. the membership application must be approved by the Board.

With the migration to electronic registrations through Sports TG and Player HQ this is not feasible.

Accordingly, the Board has released an Ordinary membership form on the new website. To assist with the transition and minimise any inconvenience, the Association has agreed to wave the fee for any current players who wish to become Ordinary Members in 2022.

For those that do not wish to apply for Ordinary Membership, there is no requirement to do so and this will not affect your ability to continue to participate in your relevant competition, you will continue as an Associate Member in line with your current player registration for the duration for your competition season.

If you elect to apply for Ordinary Membership, the new completed membership applications will need to be submitted to the secretary of the Rockingham Basketball and Recreation Association by email to the Board for approval.

In respect of non players the Board will require aspiring members to complete the form and pay a fee of \$30 and receive board approval in order to become a voting member.

Should any NBL1 players wish to apply for Ordinary Membership they will be required to submit the same form but will have their fee waived for 2022.

In addition the new constitution will specify that Life members are entitled to vote at AGM's and Special AGM's.

The new Constitution will be released shortly.
